

9th Annual Conference on the Science of Dissemination and Implementation

Session Descriptions

Individual Oral Presentations: Individual oral presentations should be no longer than 15 minutes and can employ PowerPoint slides, if needed. Four oral presentations on a common topic will be grouped together by the planning committee for a 90-minute session with adequate time for audience Q & A.

Panel Presentations: Panel presentations are comprised of three related papers plus an optional discussant. Approximately half of the 90-minute session time should be saved for questions and discussion of the presentations.

Note: The number of panels accepted will be limited. In general, we suggest submission as individual oral presentations unless you have a compelling integrated research story that requires multiple presentations in a single session, fits well with the overall conference theme, and addresses one or more of the topic categories listed above.

Poster Presentations: Posters will be presented on a standard conference poster board. There will be a time allocated for poster discussions, to facilitate interaction with poster presenters. One poster board measuring 4 feet tall x 6 feet wide will be provided on-site for each poster presentation. All mounting supplies (e.g. push pins) will also be provided on-site. A select number of accepted posters may be invited to participate in a 'Poster Slam' session as well. There are two parts to participating in the 'Poster Slam' -- the Summary 'Poster Slam' Presentations and the traditional poster presentation itself. In the Summary Presentation session, each presenter will get approximately two minutes to present their paper to the conference participants in a session room. This will be followed by the standard poster session format.
