Frequently Asked Questions **Health Datapalooza 2019**

Below are answers to frequently asked questions about the Health Datapalooza 2019 Call for Presentations submission process. If you need additional assistance, please contact <u>Julie Ann Rudolph</u> or call 202.292.6790.

1. Do you have to be an AcademyHealth member to submit? To present?

No, we do not require membership for submissions or presentation.

2. What is the submission deadline?

The deadline for submissions is Monday, October 1, 2018 at 5:00 p.m. ET.

3. My presentation could possibly be submitted to more than one track. May I submit a single presentation to more than one track?

No. Submissions may be submitted to only one track. Please submit to the track that you consider most appropriate. AcademyHealth respects the choice made by the submitter and will not move a presentation to a different track unless specifically requested to do so by the submitter before the submission deadline.

4. Can I include more than one person on a rapid fire submission?

No. Rapid Fire submissions are for one author only and accepted submissions will be combined with other submissions to form a panel. If submitting as a group, please submit through the Call for Panels.

5. Do I have a better chance of having my submission accepted to one track over another track?

No. The acceptance rate is the same for all tracks. The number of presentations selected is proportionate to the number of submissions to that track.

6. How do I submit a panel?

Panel proposals are submitted by the chair/moderator and include a panel overview (1,000-words or less) of the panel and a session summary (50-words or less). The overview should not include the names of the panelists

7. Can I submit research that has been published or is under review for publication? Yes. AcademyHealth does not have any restrictions regarding publication.

8. Can I submit work that has already been presented?

Yes. AcademyHealth is committed to the dissemination of health services research. As long as the work has not been presented at an AcademyHealth meeting, it may be submitted.

9. Once I have submitted a submission, may I make edits?

Yes. You may edit your submission until 5:00 p.m. ET on Monday, October 1, 2018. You can log back into the submission system using your username and password to edit your submission.

10. How do I know my submission has been received?

You will receive an automated email when you have completed your submission. This will include instructions for editing your submission until the deadline.

11. What is the total word limit of my submission?

The total word limit for a rapid fire submission is 300-words beginning with the Health or Healthcare Problem/Challenge Being Tackled section. The section headers (e.g. Innovation/Advance Achieved, Types of Data used etc.) and title of the submission are not included in the word count. For the overview section of a panel, the limit is 1,000-words.

12. Can I withdraw a submission?

Yes, you can withdraw your submission from consideration by using the "withdraw" option.

13. If my submission is selected for presentation but I am unavailable to present, may I send a substitute to the meeting?

14. When will I be notified about the status of my abstract?

Notifications will be sent via email in November 2018.
